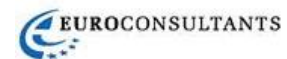

A special networking workshop dedicated to Objectives 3.1 – 3.3 of the CIP ICT PSP will be promoted alongside for those participants interested in **ICT for Health, Ageing Well and Inclusion**. The event will take place in Brussels, on the 15th of January 2013.
